	Recyclable materials	Non-Recyclables
RECYCLABLES	PLACE IN RECYCLE BIN	PLACE IN TRASH
 Glass	All clear, green and brown food and beverage containers ONLY . Remove all plastic & metal caps. Place caps in bin. Labels do not have to be removed . Do not place in Plastic Bag	Ceramic items, flowerpots, crystal, light bulbs, mirrors, ovenware and window glass. Plastic lids.
 Metal/Aluminum	Metal & Aluminum food & beverage containers. Aluminum food & Pie trays. Remove all plastic lids & caps. Labels do not have to be removed . Do Not Place In Plastic Bag	Paint cans, automotive parts, pipe, gutters, pots and pans, toys and silverware.
 Paper	Everything that comes with your newspaper. All magazines, catalogs, junk mail office paper and telephone books. Place in paper bag in your bin. Do Not Place In Plastic Bag	Pizza boxes, waxed board, hard cover books, tissue paper, napkins, wrapping paper, any food-soiled paper.
 Cardboard	All brown cardboard. All brown paper bags. Boxboard such as, Cereal, Shoe & Gift boxes. Flatten boxes into a section no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet. No Pizza Boxes	Wax coated, soiled boxes, cardboard lined with foam or laminated material. Frozen food boxes. Pizza boxes, fast food, beer & pop cases.
 Plastic	Milk jugs, beverage, windshield washer fluid, detergent, bleach containers, butter tubs, yogurt, cool whip, cottage cheese and plant pot containers. Flip top lids. Remove metal caps & lids. Also Gable top cartons Milk & Juice. Flatten Milk jugs if possible. Do Not Place In Plastic Bags.	Empty anti-freeze, motor oil containers. Plates, tableware, toys, medicine bottles or tupperware. Deli containers. Plastic bags return to Wegmans or Tops
